5. Initiatives were taken to avail of the facilities offered by the Health Scheme, provided by the State Government.

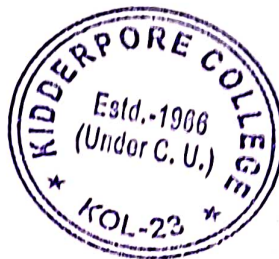

3. The teams that were formed to prepare the AQARs of 2017 – 2018 and 2018 – 2019 started working in this direction.

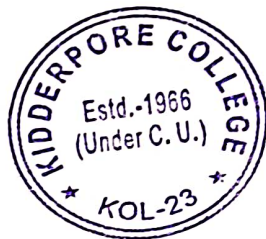
