PREAMBLE

Whereas, Maheshtala College & Kidderpore College have many areas of common interest in the subjects of Humanities, considerable advantages may be gained from their pursuance of academic excellence on a collaborative field of academics, pedagogy & Research.

Whereas, Maheshtala College & Kidderpore College have decided to enter in to this Memorandum of Understanding which defines the framework for the cooperation of this two institutes in the following sections of articles.

ARTICLE 1: OBJECT

Whereas, Maheshtala College & Kidderpore College both are agreed to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest on the basis of mutual equality & reciprocity.

Whereas, Maheshtala College & Kidderpore College both are agreed to promote the following activities keeping the financial costs in all manners to the minimum. The involvement to the activities worked out by both institutes as per this MOU are as follows:

A. Faculty Exchange:

- l) Faculty Exchange for the mutual benefit & interest of both the institutes.

- II) Collaboration in Teaching, Research, Development & Consultancy Studies for the mutual benefit & interest of both the institutes.
- III) Participating in Seminars, Workshops, Symposia & other kind of academic discussion for the mutual benefit & interest of both the institutes.

B. Other Academic Programme:

- I) Exchange the information on teaching-learning & literature based programme.
- II) Organise the seminars, faculty development programme, workshops jointly on the topics of mutual interest & to invite the faculties of both institutes to participate therein.
- III) Explore the provisions of cultural & intellectual enrichment as well as opportunities for faculties of both institutes to participate therein..
- IV) Use library & reading room facilities applicable for a specific period with prior approval of the Principal.

ARTICLE 2: TERMS & CONDITIONS

Whereas, Maheshtala College & Kidderpore College both are agreed for that detailed terms & conditions which guide the activities identified above. The terms & conditions would be determined & settled separately by both the institutes in time to time. These terms & conditions will include the technical description of proposed activities, financial arrangements & person/persons responsibilities for the ultimate implementation.

ARTICLE 3: COORDINATION

Whereas, each institute will appoint two members of its teaching faculty to coordinate the programme on behalf of the Principal of that institute. The one of those two members would be the coordinator & the other would be the joint coordinator by name. However, A coordination committee consisting of two Principals along with two coordinators & two joint coordinators will review the activities performed in an academic session by both institutes related to this MOU periodically. A joint meeting of both institutes would take place once in a year after reviewing the same.

ARTICLE 4: CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

Whereas, both institutes will retain & respect the individual confidentiality including those pertaining to the collaborative activities performed by both institutes.

ARTICLE 5: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

Whereas, the ownership of any intellectual property including but not limited to the confidential information, patents, copyrights, design rights or rights related to the computer software or any other industrial or intellectual property developed jointly during the course of this MOU shall be vested in both of the institutes. Both the institute shall have right to determine the commercial implications, disposition & exploitation of such intellectual property & shall make joint applications for the registration of the same. Any publication regarding such intellectual property shall be possible with prior written consent of the Principals of both the institutes.

ARTICLE 6: VALIDITY

Whereas, the MOU shall remain in force for a period of 5 (Five) years commencing from the date of effect (i.e. 17.11.2021). The validity of the MOU may be renewed or extended by a written agreement signed by the Principals of both institutes after a successful review.

ARTICLE 7: TERMINATION

Whereas, the MOU may be terminated by any one of the institute by giving a written notice of six months in advance to the other institute.

ARTICLE 8: LEGAL EFFECT

Whereas, the MOU has no such interpretation in connection to legal relationship in between the two institutes. This memorandum is a statement of intent to foster the genuine & mutual collaboration for the benefit of both the institutes.

ARTICLE 9: RESOLUTION OF DISPUTE

Whereas, in any dispute to any aspect of academic cooperation in regards to this MOU, Principals of both institutes will interact jointly to resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect & shared responsibilities.

Maheshtala College & Kidderpore College both are agreed & welcome the establishment of this Memorandum of Understanding jointly to the provisions stated above on this 17 th day of November, 2021.

Deshbandhu College for Girls, 45/C Rashbehari Avenue, Kolkata - 700026, West Bengal, India, represented by its Principal, Dr. Anita Chattopadhyay Gupta, hereinafter referred to as the FIRST PARTY (which term or expression shall unless excluded by or repugnant to the context be deemed to mean and include its successor in Office, representatives, administrators, and assigns), and Kidderpore College, 2 & 3 Pitamber Sircar Lane, Kolkata - 700023, West Bengal, India, represented by its Principal, Dr. Abhijit Ganguly, hereinafter referred to as the SECOND PARTY (which term or expression shall unless excluded by or repugnant to the context be deemed to mean and include its successor in Office, representatives, administrators, and assigns). Both these Institutions will be hereafter referred to as Parties.

II. PURPOSE OF THE AGREEMENT

Both the Parties are pleased to enter upon an agreement to establish ties of academic cooperation in order to contribute to the achievement of their overall goals as Institutions through the following but not limited to activities:

1. Joint teaching and research projects
2. Collaboration in the area of academic publications
3. Visit, training and exchange of faculty and students

5. Co-hosting and participation in National/International conferences, seminars/webinars, symposia and workshops including student seminars and/or paper presentations
6. Any other activity that is mutually agreed upon and is beneficial to both.

III. EXECUTION OF AGREEMENT

The specific activities to be carried out under this agreement will be stated in corresponding specific sub-agreements. Such specific sub-agreements, once approved by both Parties, will be attached as annexure to this agreement.

The specific sub-agreements between both Parties will specify their objectives, conditions and ways of execution, financial support, period of the sub-agreement will be in effect, and administrative responsibility within the purview of each Institution.

IV. TERMS AND EXPIRATION OF THE AGREEMENT

It is understood that this agreement will come into effect after being signed by both Parties and will be established for a period of 5 (five) years. VI. SPECIAL PROVISIONS

1. Each Party will take approval from the other Party in writing prior to using the latter's name and logo for the activities hereunder on a case-by-case basis.
2. All parties hereto shall do their utmost to ensure the smooth and efficient implementation of the programs.
3. The parties will consult with each other for any subsequent associated agreement informally and attempt to resolve disputes or misunderstandings that may arise in the administration of this MOU or any subsequent associated agreement informally.
4. Neither party can misuse this MOU by involving the name of the other without the written consent letter from the other party.
5. There will be no financial involvement by neither of the Party.
6. This collaboration will respect Intellectual Property Rights and any intellectual matter developed by the collaborative efforts of the two Parties shall be retained by them.
7. All collaborative activities shall be guided, directed and impelled by the greater academic interest of both the Parties, and not by any other/commercial interest.

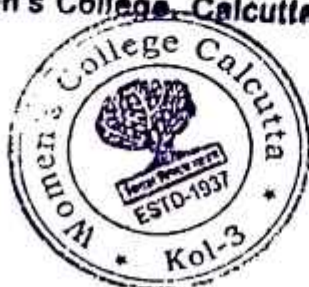





- i) to make available for the said purpose necessary infrastructure such as two rooms each of size at least 600 sq ft. and provide services for efficient running of the Centre, including receiving of study materials from the University and distribution of the same to individual student;
- ii) To provide the class rooms/ seminar room as per requirements of the teaching-learning processes.
- iii) to comply with the Rules and Regulations, which are already in force and/ or which to be introduced by the University &/or the UGC-Distance Education Bureau (DEB) &/or other statutory body(ies) as may be applicable, in respect of LSCs / Study Centres from time to time;
- iv) to run the Post Graduate LSCs / Study Centres offering Arts, Commerce & Mathematics only out of the share amount received from the University in this regard as per the norms of the University which are in force and which may be promulgated from time to time.
- v) to maintain complete records of:-
 - (a) all expenses including those incurred out of the amount received by the LSC/ Study Centre,
 - (b) student enrolment, renewal and assessment in different subjects,
 - (c) academic and supportive staff working at the LSC/ Study Centre and
 - (d) all programmes of the LSC/ Study Centre;
- vi) to conduct examinations as and when required, in consonance with the schedule announced by the University;
- vii) to send regular reports to Director, Study Centres and/or other concerned officers of the University regarding the activities, needs and progress of the LSC/ Study Centre and to allow visiting teams consisting of University authorities and/ or any person who may be authorized by the University for monitoring purposes.
- viii) All teachers (including SACT-I) of LSCs have to participate in any academic activities as and when instructed by the University.
- ix) To engage coordinator along with other supporting staff following the G.B. (of the College/HEI concerned) resolution under intimation to the Director, Study Centres, NSOU.
- x) It would be the responsibility of all academic counsellors attached to the LSC/ Study Centre to participate in the teaching-learning and evaluation process of NSOU viz., Personal Contact Programme (PCP) and evaluation of answer papers of the Term-End and Assignment Examinations as may be assigned to them from time to time by the concerned authority of the college/ LSC/ Study Centre and/or NSOU.
- xi) LSCs/Study Centres will have to conduct laboratory based activities /field work/dissertation/hands on training (as would be applicable) for the enrolled learners of the University as and when instructed by the University.
- xii) The Principal/Teacher-in-Charge/Officer-in-Charge and Coordinator shall abide by the provisions of the relevant sections of NSOU Statutes /Law/Regulations and other directions which may be relevant for the purpose of the smooth running of the LSCs / Study Centres.



- xiii) LSCs / Study Centres shall create a TAB in the college Website for NSOU to give all information relating to the University. All the notices and schedules relating to Admission, Renewal, Personal Contact Programme, Examinations etc will be uploaded on the relevant link (TAB) of the college website.
- xiv) The Learner Support Centre/ Study Centre will put a notice board and signboard depicting the University name and logo at a distinct place in the college premises in order to make the same visible.
- xv) It shall be the responsibility of the LSC/ Study Centres to submit the Audit Report of the grants received by them by 31st May each year.
- xvi) Programme Offered : Vide Annexure (the programmes offered by the university to the LSC/Study Centre are provided in the annexure herein and shall be treated as the part and parcel of this agreement).
- xvii) The LSCs/study centre will organize Induction Meeting before the commencement of each academic session with newly admitted students. University officials (faculties/officer) may participate in the programme whenever necessary on invitation.
- xviii) The LSCs/ study centre should strictly follow the normal working hours which are as follows::
- Saturday (2pm to 5pm); Sunday (10.30am to 5.30pm)
- xix) The college/Higher Education Institution will not open more than two LSCs of two different Universities including NSOU. And it shall be the duty of the college to inform the NSOU if and when the second LSC is opened and put to function.
- xx) Neither Party will be liable for any failure or delay in performing an obligation under this Agreement that is due to any of the following causes (which events and/or circumstances are hereinafter referred to as "Force Majeure"), to the extent beyond its reasonable control: acts of God, accident, riots, war, terrorist act, epidemic, pandemic, quarantine, civil commotion, breakdown of communication facilities, breakdown of web host, breakdown of internet service provider, natural catastrophes, governmental acts or omissions, alteration, variation and repeal in laws or regulations that are in force, national strikes, fire, explosion, generalized lack of availability of raw materials or energy; provided that the parties stipulate that Force Majeure shall not include the novel coronavirus Covid-19 pandemic which is ongoing as of the date of the execution of this agreement.

For the avoidance of doubt, Force Majeure shall not include:-


- (a) financial distress nor the inability of either party to make a profit or avoid a financial loss,
- (b) changes in the market prices or conditions, or
- (c) a party's financial inability to perform its obligations hereunder.

This Force Majeure Clause applies for parties entering into the instant contract in the midst of the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic, and with restrictions imposed by the appropriate government which want to ensure that current existing circumstances at the time of execution of this agreement and/ or MOU are not considered Force Majeure events.

- xxi) In case of any litigation the High Court of Calcutta, should be the authority.

- xxii) The Clauses on Termination of this instant agreement shall be made on mutually agreed conditions subject to the protection of learners' interest and without causing any prejudice to them who are already enrolled.
- xxiii) This MOU is subject to further revision, if any, when the Regulations of the University comes into force

This MOU comes into effect on the 27th day of December 2022 and this is in continuation of the previous MOU(s)



This Memorandum of Understanding is made in this 1st day of February 2023 for a period of 5 (Five) years with the provision to renew on demand by and between PHYSICAL EDUCATION FOUNDATION (PEF), West Bengal Chapter & KIDDERPORE COLLEGE.

The obligations of the Parties will end on 21.12.2024. In case of renewal shall be mutually agreed beforehand.







PREAMBLE

Whereas, Kidderpore College & Jibantala Rokeya Mahaviyalaya have many areas of common interest in the subjects of Humanities, considerable advantages may be gained from their pursuance of academic excellence on a collaborative field of academics, pedagogy, culture & research.

Whereas, Kidderpore College & Jibantala Rokeya Mahavidyalaya have decided to enter in to this Memorandum of Understanding which defines the framework for the cooperation of this two institutes in the following sections of articles.

ARTICLE 1: OBJECT

Whereas, Kidderpore College & Jibantala Rokeya Mahavidyalaya both are agreed to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest on the basis of mutual equality & reciprocity.

Whereas, Kidderpore College & Jibantala Rokeya Mahavidyalaya both are agreed to promote the following activities keeping the financial costs in all manners to the minimum. The involvement to the activities worked out by both institutes as per this MOU are as follows:

Faculty Exchange:

Faculty Exchange for the mutual benefit & interest of both the institutes.

Collaboration in Teaching, Research, Development & Consultancy Studies for the mutual benefit & interest of both the institutes.

Participating in Seminars, Workshops, Symposia & other kind of academic discussion for the mutual benefit & interest of both the institutes.

Other Academic Programme:

Exchange the information on teaching-learning & literature based programme.

Organise the academic & cultural seminars, faculty development programme, workshops jointly on the topics of mutual interest & to invite the faculties of both institutes to participate therein.

Explore the provisions of cultural & intellectual enrichment as well as opportunities for faculties of both institutes to participate therein.

Use library & reading room facilities applicable for a specific period with prior approval of the Principal.

ARTICLE 2: TERMS & CONDITIONS

Whereas, Kidderpore College & Jibantaia Rokeya Mahavidyalaya both are agreed for that detailed terms & conditions which guide the activities identified above. The terms & conditions would be determined & settled separately by both the institutes in time to time. These terms & conditions will include the technical description of proposed activities, financial arrangements & person/persons responsibilities for the ultimate implementation.

ARTICLE 3: COORDINATION

Whereas, each institute will appoint two members of its teaching faculty to coordinate the programme on behalf of the Principal of that institute. The one of those two members would be the coordinator & the other would be the joint coordinator by name. However, A coordination committee consisting of two Principals along with two coordinators & two joint coordinators will review the activities performed in an academic session by both institutes related to this MOU periodically. ARTICLE 4: CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

ARTICLE 5: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

Whereas, the ownership of any intellectual property including but not limited to the confidential information, patents, copyrights, design rights or rights related to the computer software or any other industrial or intellectual property developed jointly during the course of this MOU shall be vested in both of the institutes. Both the institute shall have right to determine the commercial implications, disposition & exploitation of such intellectual property & shall make joint applications for the registration of the same. Any publication regarding such intellectual property shall be possible with prior written consent of the Principals of both the institutes.

ARTICLE 6: VALIDITY

Whereas, the MOU shall remain in force for a period of 2 (Two) years commencing from the date of effect (i.e. 02.05.2023). The validity of the MOU may be renewed or extended by a written agreement signed by the Principals of both institutes after a successful review.

ARTICLE 7: TERMINATION


A PROGRAMME ON INCLUSIVE EDUCATION FOR PERSONS WITH SINGLE OR MULTIPLE DISABILITIES



Report for the Student Awareness Programme on Marginalized People: Social Inclusion and Rights held on 12th May, 2023 at Room Number 9 of Kidderpore College


Mrs Mallika Das, Programme Coordinator, KSEDA while speaking on the issue of Social Inclusion of Marginalized People stated that in order to prepare a full proof strategy for the upliftment of the marginalized people general and the disabled in particular, it is necessary to have exact data on the number of disabled people in India. As definitions have changed over the years and a very skeptical attitude reflected by the responders, the people of disabled India has been reported at an abysmal low as compared to many developed nations. The work for inclusion of disabled in the mainstream has suffered immensely due to the lack of data.


However, a lot of work has still been done on the institutional front. She informed the students regarding various acts, the PWD Act (1995), National Trust Act(1999), undertaken by the Government so far towards inclusion of the disabled in the mainstream and higher education.

She emphasized on the importance of barrier free, bright classrooms with wheelchair accessibility for inclusion of students with disabilities.

- a) Whereas, 3 (Three) faculties of Journalism & Mass Communication, Department of Kidderpore College will take 3 (three) Theoretical Classes per week in on-line mode.
 - b) Whereas, 1 (One) faculty of Journalism & Mass Communication, Department of Kidderpore College will take 1 (One) Practical Class per week in off-line mode.
 - c) Whereas, 4 (Four) faculties of English, Department of Bhangar Mahavidyalaya will take 4 (four) Theoretical Classes per week in on-line mode.
 - d) Whereas, each teacher of each college will conduct the classes by using Google/You Tube platform through internet with the host institution.
 - e) Whereas, no remuneration or any kind of other expenses would be paid to the teachers by both the institutions for conducting the classes in this regard.
 - f) Whereas, the students of Bhangar Mahavidyalaya may use the laboratory of Department of Journalism & Mass Communication, Kidderpore College for the necessary purpose of their study/course with full of care, responsibility & sincerity towards the host institution.
 - g) Whereas, the students of Bhangar Mahavidyalaya will bear his/her own transportation cost and daily allowances to and from the host institution by himself/herself.

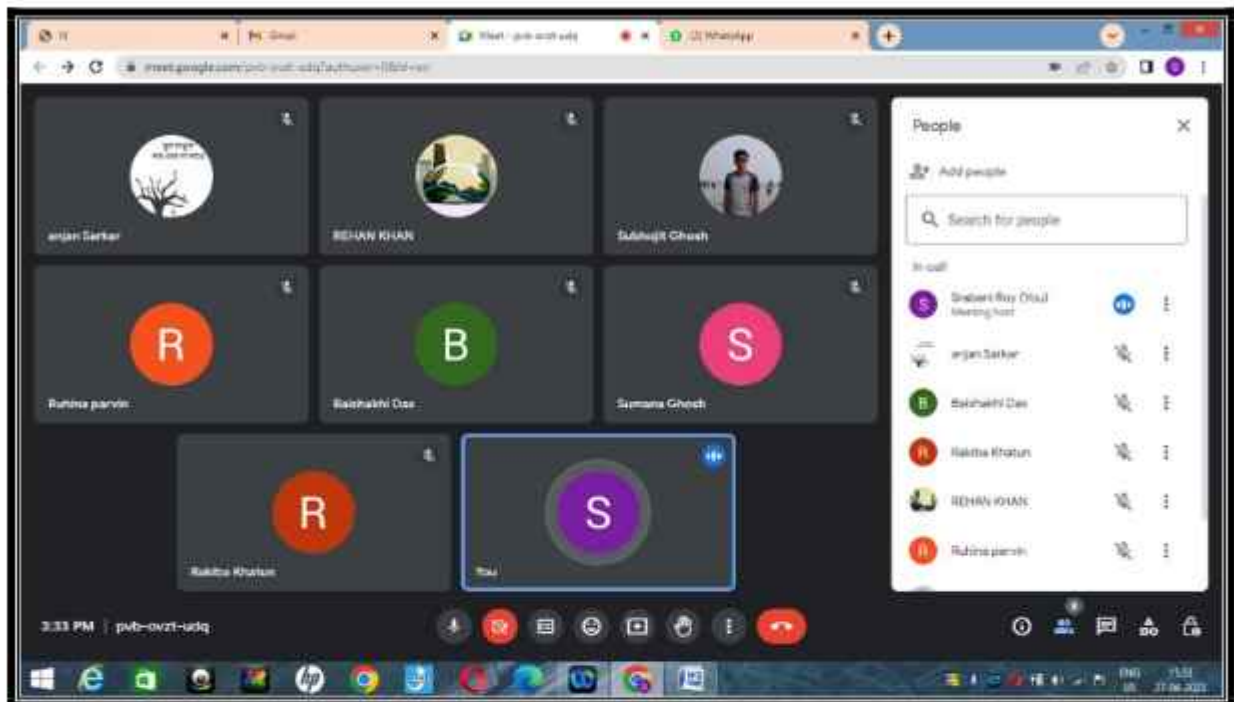

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Blood Donation Camp, Lecture Sessions/ Seminar/ Celebration of National Importance/ Integrity Day/ Ex-N.C.C. Students Felicitation Day, Decomposition/Reuse/Recycling of Organic Wastes & Plastic Waste, Plantation/Plant Donation Program, Disaster Management & Relief Operations, Rescue Mangrove Forests.

- a) Whereas, the N.C.C. cadets & official staff of both the colleges agree to organise **Blood Donation Camp** jointly at least once in a particular period of a single academic year/session.
- b) Whereas, the N.C.C. cadets & official staff of both the colleges agree to organise several **Lecture Sessions or Seminar or Celebration for National Importance/Integrity Day or Ex-N.C.C. Cadets Felicitation Day** at least once in a particular period of a single academic session.
- c) Whereas, the 15 (fifteen) members of N.C.C. cadets & official staff along with Ex- students Alumni of each college agree to construct an active group named **"Yuva Chetna Sangathan"** jointly.
- d) Whereas, **Yuva Chetna Sangathan** agree to conduct several Awareness Programme on **Decomposition/Reuse/Recycling of Organic Wastes & Plastic Waste** in Sea-Shore as well as Commercial Area of Kolkata Municipal Corporation & South 24 Parganas.
- e) Whereas, **Yuva Chetna Sangathan** agree to conduct **Plantation/Plant Donation Program** in a populated area of Kolkata Municipal Corporation/South 24 Parganas at least once in a particular period of a single academic session.
- f) Whereas, **Yuva Chetna Sangathan** agree to conduct **Disaster Management & Relief Operations** in regards to prevent the damages before or after Severe Cyclone/ Natural Calamity basically in the coastal area of Sundarban.

- g) Whereas, **Yuva Chetna Sangathan** agree to conduct awareness programme in regards to **Rescue Mangrove Forests** in the coastal area of Sundarban at least once in a particular period of a single academic session.
- h) Whereas, each college will bear own costs for transportation and other allowances to and from the host institution in all regards.
- i) Whereas, each college shall appoint one coordinator from the teaching faculties to coordinate each programme on behalf of the Principal of each college. Further, a coordination committee consisting of the Principals of both the colleges and the coordinators of both the colleges will conduct meeting & review periodically to identify the problems & strengthen the ways for more cooperation in between the two colleges.
- j) Whereas, ownership of intellectual property, related to know-how, patents, copyrights, design rights, rights related to computer software and any other industrial or intellectual property rights developed jointly during this MoU shall be vested in both the colleges.
- k) Whereas, both the colleges shall have the right to determine the commercial implications, disposition and exploitation of such intellectual property and shall make the joint applications for the registration of the same.
- l) Whereas, this MoU shall be construed as a statement of purpose to promote the mutual benefit of collaboration in between both the colleges & nothing in this MoU will remain to create any legal relationship in between both the colleges.
- m) Whereas, both the colleges agree to work together in good faith and in case of a dispute relating to any aspect in conducting any programme on academic & social consciousness/ cooperation/ encouragement, the Principals of both the colleges will jointly resolve the matter in a spirit of independence, mutual respect and shared responsibility.
- n) Whereas, this MoU may be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by the representatives of both the colleges.
- o) Whereas, the effective date of this MoU is the date of signature which is affixed to the last page of this MoU agreement.




