

Minutes of the IQAC Meeting dated: 16.1.2026

The minutes of the previous IQAC Meeting dated 16.9.2025 were confirmed.

- Prof. Pilu Chandra Das said that Models of Student management Software and Websites offered by reputed companies are only demonstrated but not purchased. Unless student management softwares are timely purchased and installed the work of data entry and data maintenance cannot be successfully done. So it was resolved that Mr. Sudhansu Sekhar Mal would be invited at the earliest to reinstate the student management software and start the data entry work at the earliest.
- It was resolved that a Student Management Software Committee would be constituted and merged with the Website Committee for the successful maintenance of data. The members of the Finance Committee particularly speaking Dr. Dibyendu Roy and Dr. Prabodh Kumar Misra were advised to be made members of the merged committees. A meeting of the merged committee was also advised to be organized at the earliest.
- Dr. Srabani Roy Maiti was assigned the duty to prepare the Academic Audit with the active assistance of Dr. Amrita bhattacharya and Dr. Anwar Seraj. While Prof. Pilu Chandra Das was assigned the duty of preparing the Administrative Audit.
- With regard to the issue of E-Waste Management it was suggested that some organization other than Hulladec would be approached for E-Waste Management. In this regard the Equipments Committee was advised to keep a record of all the equipments including the available e-wastes of the College.
- Prof. Pilu Chandra Das informed that the academic calendar for the session 2025-26 has been successfully uploaded in the College Website.
- It was resolved that henceforth all the programmes of all the subcommittees of the College must be conducted in collaboration with all the Colleges with whom the College has a MOU and with the centres of potential excellence moct

notably Ashutosh College, Deshbandhu College For Girls, Bijoy Krishna Girls' College and New Alipore College.

- It was stated that the NIRF emphasized on Women representation and women empowerment in the Educational Institutions. So to score better rank all the subcommittees were advised to reserve a certain percentage of seats for women faculties.

- It was stated that preliminary discussions were held with Government Girls' College, Harimohan Ghose College for organizing a Women's Football League . The committee for conducting the football match was proposed to constitute the following members:

Dr. Mijanur Rahaman, Dr. Chandrabali Das, Dr. Dibyendu Roy, Dr. Srabani Roy Maiti, Dr. Mahmuda Khanam , Prof. Pilu Chandar Das, Dr. Sujata Ghosh and Captain Biplab Dhara.

- It was resolved that a MOU would be signed with the Consumer Forum, Government of West Bengal. In this regard it was suggested that all the MOUs which have expired till date must be renewed at the earliest.

- It was proposed that a job fair must be organized in the College premises within the month of February.

- It was proposed that an FDP preferably on the Indian Knowledge System (IKS) must be conducted in collaboration with the following centers of potential excellence:

- a. Deshbandhu College For Girls
- b. Bijoykrishna Girls' College
- c. Ashutosh College
- d. New Alipore College.

It was stated that the colleges with whom Kidderpore College has entered MOU can also be integrated in the process.

- It was resolved that the peer perception of the College has to be strengthened and for that the College updates must be posted on all possible social media platforms.

Finally the meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair and all the members present.
