## **Objective of the Programme**

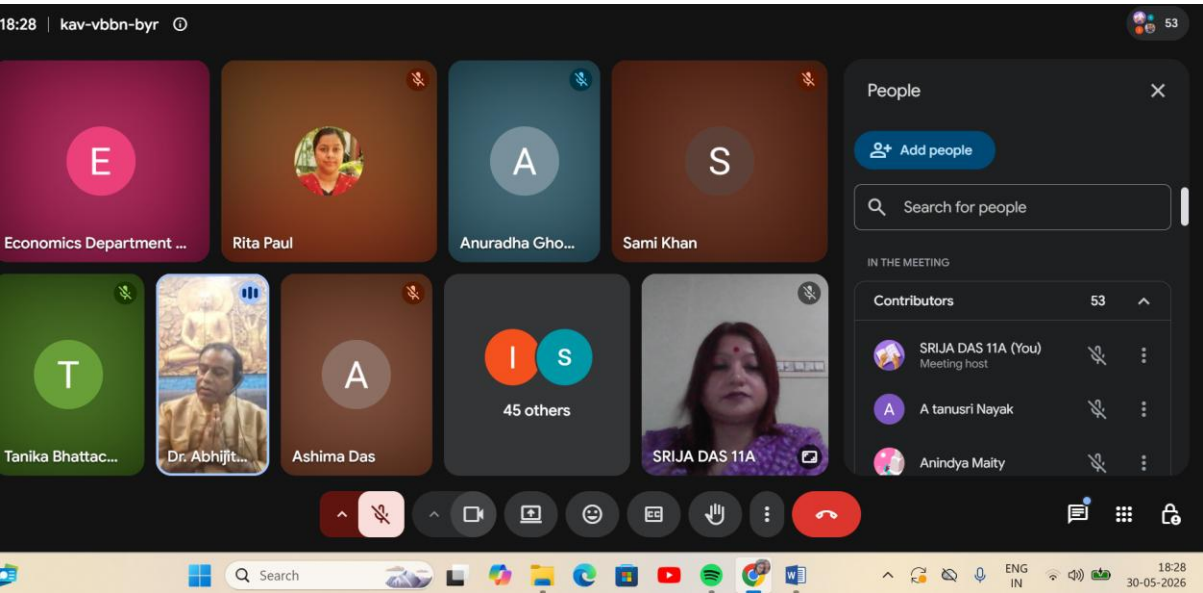
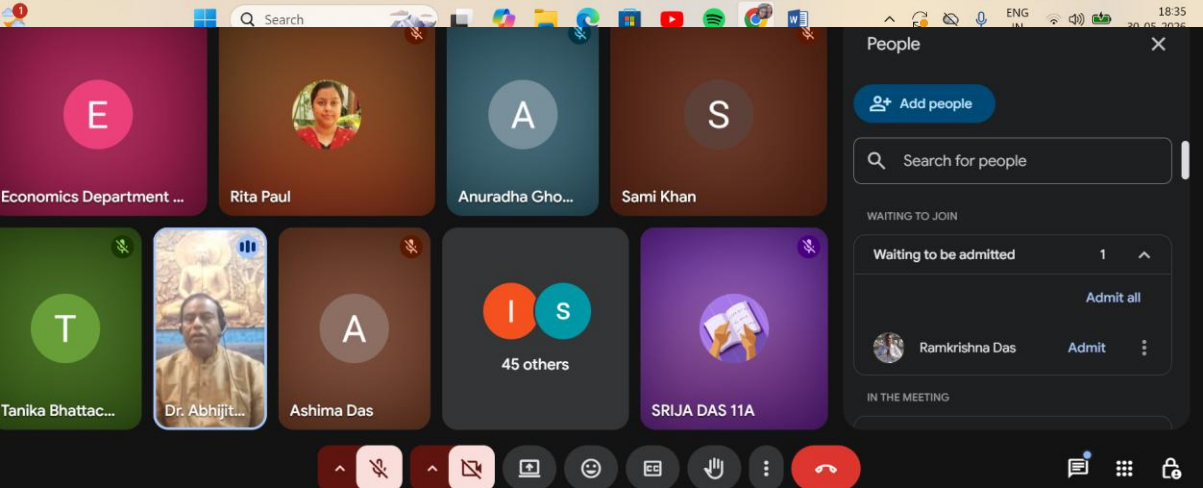
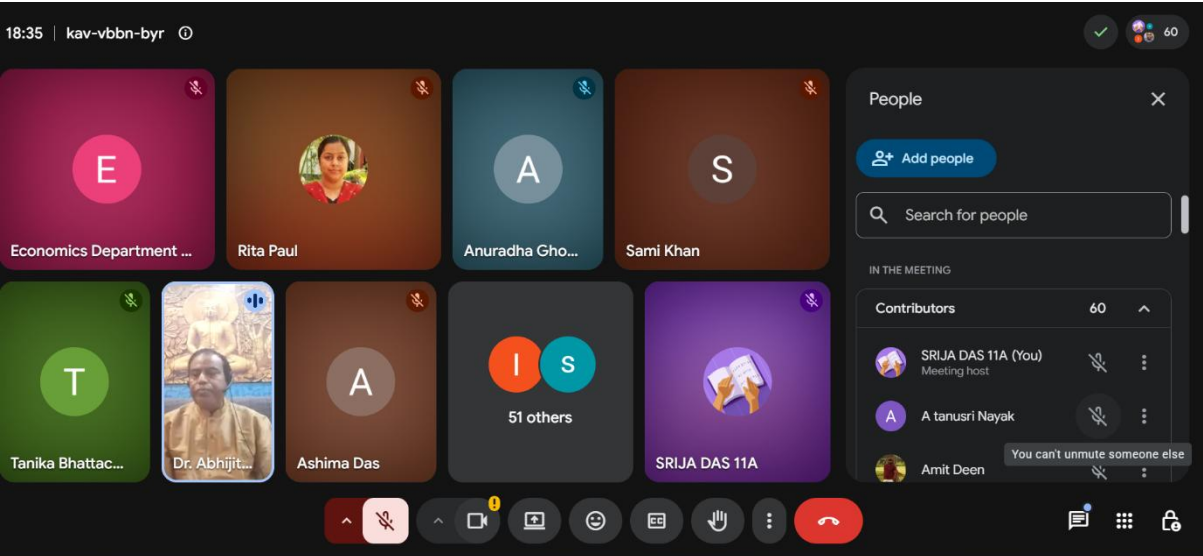
